Mighty Fortress						<p>Try to solve this logic puzzle using the paragraph and clues below!</p> <p>Four youth like different opportunities at church (serving as an acolyte, chimes, praise team, and mission trips), four different songs (“A Mighty Fortress,” “Lord, I Lift Your Name on High,” “Jesus Loves Me,” and “Holy, Holy, Holy”), and four different Scriptures (Proverbs 3:5, John 3:16, Psalm 23, and Matthew 28). Using the clues, figure out who likes what. (Hint-put a circle in each box if the information matches; put an X in each box if the information does not match. In other words, if Sally liked chimes, you would put a circle in the box where “Sally” and “chimes” meet.)</p>
