

## Logic Puzzle Answer Key

Emily does not do anything in music, therefore she does not do chimes or praise team.

John 3:16 is liked by a girl, therefore it is not liked by either Frank or William.

William likes Mission Trips, and the child who likes mission trips also likes “A Mighty Fortress,” therefore William likes “A Mighty Fortress.”

Since William likes Mission Trips, and Emily does not do chimes or praise team, the only one left is serving as an acolyte. Therefore Emily likes being an acolyte.

The Proverbs Scripture is only a verse, therefore Emily likes the Psalms *chapter*. (Matthew and John are in the *New Testament*.)

This means that Emily did not pick John 3:16, and neither did the boys (clue 2), so Sally likes John 3:16.

Emily likes serving as acolyte (above), William likes Mission Trips (clue 4), and Sally likes chimes (clue 6), so Frank likes Praise Team.

Frank likes Praise Team, so he also likes “Lord, I Lift Your Name.” The person who likes chimes is Sally (clue 6), so Sally also likes “Jesus Loves Me.”

And William likes “A Mighty Fortress,” so the only song left is “Holy, Holy, Holy,” therefore Emily likes “Holy, Holy, Holy.”

Sally likes John 3:16 (above), so William likes Matthew 28. (Psalms and Proverbs are in the *Old Testament*.)

The only Scripture left is Proverbs 3:5, therefore Frank likes Proverbs 3:5. So:

Emily likes serving as an acolyte, “Holy, Holy, Holy,” and Psalm 23.

Frank likes praise team, “Lord, I Lift Your Name on High,” and Proverbs 3:5.

Sally likes chimes, “Jesus Loves Me,” and John 3:16.

William likes mission trips, “A Mighty Fortress,” and Matthew 28.
